The next step in the discussions will be to proceed with a due diligence process which will further identify the combined strengths and benefits in operating as one combined entity serving all the communities currently served by the two separate organizations.

The due diligence process will further identify and confirm the benefits and will provide additional detail for both staff and members. This will be brought to the membership of each respective credit union for approval in late November or early December. The merger must be approved by the members and the appropriate regulatory bodies before completion.

By combining the organization the new credit union will have a base of

nearly \$120 million dollars in assets allowing the credit union increased ability to provide loans and deposit services to members of the communities well into the future. The move better positions the credit union to continue to provide excellent service to members and remain more competitive and better positioned for future needs of the members. The move reconfirms the commitment to members and community by remaining in the community providing leadership and support and allows the credit union to maintain its strong community support and participation.

Members will be able to access their accounts through any of the four local branches and through electronic means like ATM's, home banking, debit cards, credit cards etc.

Further information will be communicated as the process proceeds and more details are available. If you have any questions or comments regarding the merger please feel free to contact any of your board members or stop by the branches and speak to one of the managers or staff, they will be happy to discuss this with you.

- 2) Know before you pay. Get instant account balance information before you get to the checkout line.
- 3) Have peace of mind. Get instant activity information so you know exactly



what's happening in your account.

- 4) Call off the search party. There's no need to find a computer. Just pull out your mobile phone and get the information you need.
- 5) Stop waiting around. Get instant account information within seconds of sending your request.
